



### **Dreamfall by Amy Plum**




### **You May Now Kill the Bride by R.L. Stine**


### **The Sacrifice Box by Martin Stewart**


### **The Dark Descent of Elizabeth Frankenstein by Kiersten White**






### Alone by Cyn Balog





### Here There Are Monsters by Amelinda Bérubé




### Pet by Akwaeke Emezi


### His Hideous Heart Edited by Dahlia Adler




### Sawkill Girls by Claire Legrand
